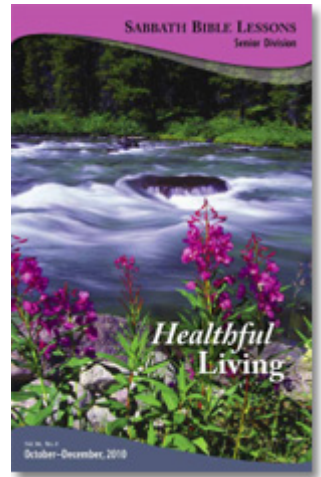
## 4. Seven Prayer Ideas for 2011
