information and ideas that God can use to help your church grow. Please call ahead so we can have enough books ordered (317) 844-6201, ask for Sheri.

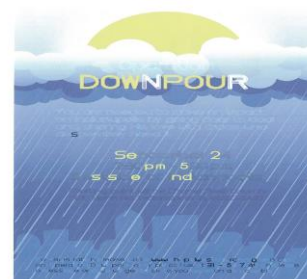
2. Indiana State Fair Outreach
